The CBR EVAC Kit contains a one-piece suit, designed to go with the SURVIVAIR® Quick2000® Escape Hood (used by the Pentagon, Congress and State Department). The protective ability of the Sigmon system was evaluated to be significantly better than its competitors. This better protection was attributed to the one-piece design that has gloves and re-enforced footing built in as a single piece along with the addition of absorptive carbon fabric around the openings. The hood and suit have been designed to pull on in approximately one minute. The evaluation used the Vapor Protection Min-in-simulant test (MIST), with simulant agents.
